A Reminder - If you have not renewed your 2025 membership, please do so...This year is slipping away too quickly. The Dues are \$47.00 for 2025. You can pay by check or cash at the lounge/bar or by mail. You also have the option to pay online using a credit card at the national website www.mylegion.org.
